

Documents Required for Kindergarten Registration

1. Student's **BIRTH CERTIFICATE** -DOB on or before 9/1/12. (a copy of the Birth Certificate is sufficient or we can make a copy for you.)

2. **PROOF OF RESIDENCE and EVIDENCE OF RESIDENCY**

If you own the property you reside in, we require:

- Copy of most recent tax bill
- Copy of most recent utility bill (cable, electric, landline phone, etc.) or mortgage statement

If you lease/rent the property you reside in, we require:

- Copy of lease with a copy of the property owner's most recent property tax bill
- Copy of most recent utility bill in your name (cable, electric, landline phone, etc)

If you are living with a relative, we require:

- Notarized letter from the property owner stating the child is currently living at their Holliston address with a copy of the property owner's most recent property tax bill
- Copy of most recent insurance bill or credit card bill in your name mailed to you at the Holliston address.

All registration packets must include a signed **Residency Verification Form-** [Residency Verification Form](#)

4. A completed **Program of Choice** Sheet [Program of Choice Documentation](#)

5. Student's most recent **PHYSICAL Examination FORM** with immunizations and certification of vision screening including stereopsis. *(If you have a health related question - please call the Health Office at 508-429-0647 ext 1206.)*

Before starting school, each student must have proof of receiving the following immunizations:

6. If you are seeking financial assistance for full day kindergarten and you meet any of the criteria below, please provide the specified documentation:

A- Kindergarten student is in a household receiving benefits from MA SNAP, MA TANF, or Medicaid (Please provide your Case Number on the Free and Reduced Lunch Form and Fill out the Sharing of Information Form- [Free and Reduced Lunch Form and Sharing of Information Form- Both are Required](#))

B- Kindergarten student is a foster child who resides with you and is under the legal responsibility of a foster care agency or court (Please bring documentation identifying student as a foster child).

C- Kindergarten student meets the definition of homeless or migrant. Please notify the Placentino staff of this status at the time of registration and we will give your contact information to Mrs. Margaret Camire, our Homeless Liaison.

D- Gross Household income (all adults living in the household) is within the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines for Free and Reduced Lunch (please below/reverse side for 2016-2017 Guidelines- 2017-2018 Guidelines are not released till June, 2017).

PLEASE NOTE: Every family must reapply for free/reduced lunch status using the 2017-2018 Federal forms in September in order to verify and maintain reduced tuition rate.
